

Honorial Wall Program Commemorates Museum Supporters

The National Museum permanently recognizes contributors to its Honorial Wall Program by listing their names on the Honorial Wall located in the lobby of the Museum, just outside the exhibition entrance. Each donation receives one line of up to sixty 1" characters on the Wall that designates the name of an individual or organization. Posts/Auxiliaries entries list the name, # and state abbreviation. The minimum donation of \$1,000 goes to directly support the programs of the National Museum of American Jewish Military History. When the Museum is in receipt of \$1,000 you will be notified by letter of the receipt of the funds and that the inscription is in process. You will also receive a certificate, suitable for framing.
