# General Qualifications for Enlistment

## REGULAR ARMY

Generally speaking, to be acceptable for enlistment in the Regular Army, applicants must meet the following requirements:

They must be between the ages of 18 and 35 for original enlistment, unmarried, and those under 21 must have the written consent of parents or guardians; they must be at least 5 feet 4 inches in height and weigh not less than 115 pounds; they must be of good moral character, as evidenced by written testimonials from reputable citizens of their respective communities; they must be in good health and free from incapacitating or disfiguring deformities. They must be citizens of the United States by birth or naturalization at the time of enlistment; they must be able to pass the intelligence and literacy tests as prescribed in regulations governing recruiting for the Regular Army.

## REGULAR ARMY RESERVE

Single or married men who have been honorably discharged from the Regular Army, after one year or more continuous service therein, and who are less than thirty-six years of age and physically qualified, are eligible for enlistment in the Regular Army Reserve, in the grade held when discharged from the Regular Army.
