## DEAR CHILDREN: WE WILL NOT LET YOU DIE

Yes, we know that you are starved and frightened and ill—your eyes haunted with horror and your hearts torn with longing for parents you saw go into gas chambers and crematoria.

But, dear Children, you need no longer wish for death to rescue you. We in America have resolved that you shall live, that your broken bodies shall be mended, your broken lives made whole. We are determined that we will give you the chance to grow up as useful, decent citizens—strong and proud and free.

Your brothers and sisters had the highest place on Hitler's priority of murder. But now you have the highest place on our priority of rescue. Hold fast to your little strength. Help is on the way from America!

There are 150,000 Jewish children left alive in Europe. In history's long record of suffering, they perhaps have suffered most.

The shape of Jewish life in Europe for generations to come depends on what we do for them.

They can be saved through the United Jewish Appeal. Its agencies can supply them with food and clothes and shelter—with the medical and spiritual aid which will spare them from the grave.

To save the Jewish men, women and children of Europe and to prepare a place for them in Palestine

and elsewhere, the United Jewish Appeal needs a minimum of \$100,000,000.

The plight of the Jewish survivors is far, far worse than that of other war victims. Most of them are not receiving any aid from inter-governmental sources. They call out to us not for preferential treatment, not for special favors, but merely for the chance to survive.

The sum of \$100,000,000 can be raised, but only by the unprecedented generosity of the American community as a whole, and the Jewish community of America in particular.

We must give not only convenient dollars but sacrificial dollars. We must give not merely out of income but out of savings—yes, out of necessities if need be.

### 51st NATIONAL J.W.V. CONVENTION IN ATLANTIC CITY

(SPECIAL) In accordance with the mandate of the National Executive Committee, the National Convention Committee has decided that our 51st National Encampment shall be held at Atlantic City, November 27th to December 1st, 1946, inclusive. The Chelsea Hotel will be Convention Headquarters, with the President Hotel, as auxiliary. Other hotels in the vicinity are being canvassed, so that rooms will be available for everyone. Rates will be about equivalent to those which prevailed last year, i. e., about \$7.00 per room double, in the older building and about \$10.00 per room up double in the new building, European plan.

The Committee canvassed several cities, before deciding upon Atlantic City. The housing shortage and convenience to most delegates, as well as the desirable facilities of Atlantic City were deciding factors. Louis Rosenberg, Chairman and Dr. David Coyne, co-chairman, announce that further information will be disclosed in The Jewish Veteran and the JWV Reporter shortly.

**PERSONALS** . . . Nat Kaplan, P. Natl. Adj. was appointed Secretary to the New York City Board of Education. Congrats . . . Col. Julius Klein, now Assistant to Secretary of War Patterson, has received another high decoration . . . Sam Rose of No. 58 does a lot of speaking for the Vets Administration . . . Percy Friedlander is Co. Council Commander of VFW . . . Lewis Jaffee is recovered and Commander of Phila. JWV Co. Council . . . Harry Wengrow is Commander of Atlanta Legion Post No. 1, one of five largest in country.

**CONSTRUCTIVE** . . . Natl. Ladies Auxiliary Program. Also Speakers Kit. Their vet hospitalization program still "tops" . . . JWV Dept. of Penna. contributed to St. Francis College . . . Jewish Chaplain Herbert Eskin of WW II paid Memorial Day tribute at grave of Catholic priest, Msgr. Patrick R. Dunigan, hero of WW I . . . JWV's Chaplain Goode Memorial project has been completed by presentation of Chaplain Goode to the City Library and a miniature to Mrs. Goode . . . "The Golden Vet," new post publication of Post 170 in Reading . . . What about a provision in all housing legislation, prohibiting discrimination in rentals?

**INTER-ORGANIZATION** . . . J. G. Fredman represented JWV at National Conference of Jewish Social Welfare Agencies, discussing "Combatting of anti-Semitism through veteran and patriotic organizations" . . . NCRAC used JWV as medium to check on discrimination in employment among vets . . . JWV vet leaders in N. Y. State should be interested in Institute of Community Leadership at Syracuse Univ. July 10-24th . . . Many inquiries about expanding veteran activities of several National Jewish organizations, which it is alleged, are harmful to Jewish veterans.

**SUBVERSIVES** . . . As after WW I, KKK is taking lead in spreading terror and disunity. N.Y., Calif. and Ga. have taken legal steps against them, but they must be supported by public opinion. With such shortage of cotton goods, where do Klansmen get their sheets? . . . The charitable Friends Society was recently hoodwinked by former pro-Nazis into running a concert at Madison Sq. Garden for German relief . . . St. Louisans were greatly aroused at holding of "Nationalist Congress" led by Gerald L. K. Smith's America First Party. Smith's mass meeting and a counter meeting arranged for Veterans Memorial Hall across the street were both banned by police to prevent riots . . . Anti-semitic Charles Anderson, Jr., of Chicago, pleaded guilty to assault with deadly weapon on a 15 year old boy . . . D.A.R. Convention upheld their racial discrimination in Constitution Hall.

**SHAME** . . . 30 American Jewish businessmen intending to inaugurate air-service between USA and Palestine were refused transit visas through Egypt. This refusal involved freedom of travel by American citizens and established a dangerous precedent. Egypt is a member of United Nations. Our Louis A. Falk was one denied. What are Americans going to do about this?

**MISCELLANY** . . . The July 3rd District Attorney radio program will expose the KKK . . . Gov. Arnall of Georgia is entitled to recognition for his incessant recognition of human rights . . . This is an important election year. All vets should register and vote. How should a vet vote? Should he always prefer a veteran candidate over a more qualified candidate, who is not a veteran? As citizens, how far should this vet preference extend? . . . American Legion starts two week college course in July for 100 WW II vets, who will be grounded in Legion projects, history, policies, etc. They will then go back to communities and promote Legion. Swell idea! . . . We're still seeking an advertising solicitor for The Jewish Veteran . . . Our request last month for letters from readers, on any JWV matter, elicited little response. Wonder if you read us! . . .
