## JWV CONFAB GETS TOP ORATORS HUMPHREY AND JAVITS TO SPEAK

### LBJ Lauds JWV's Viet Veto; Vets Block Resolution

Action by the JWV at the recent Washington Plenary Session of the National Community Relations Advisory Council, central advisory body of Jewish organizations and community councils, blocked a resolution that would have given a distorted impression of the Vietnam war—and resulted in commendation of the Jewish veterans' stand by President Johnson. The N.C.R.A.C. sought to adopt a resolution expressing fear that the right of protest and dissent in America were threatened as a result of U.S. participation in the Vietnam war.

JWV felt the resolution unrealistic and inappropriate. Therefore, the JWV used its right, as a constituent group, to veto this

policy expression to prevent its issuance in the name of the N.C.R.A.C.

Although seven other major Jewish groups advocated the Vietnam resolution, JWV felt that an organization representing Jewish war veterans who knew at first hand the realities of the war situation and the need for homefront support, felt it necessary to act.

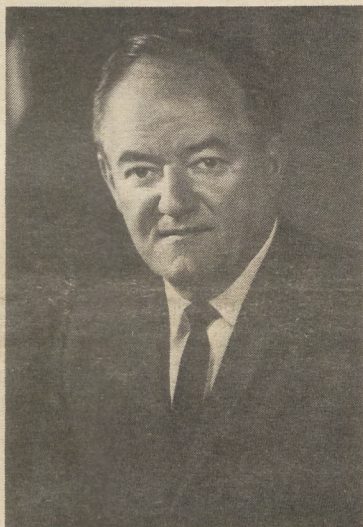

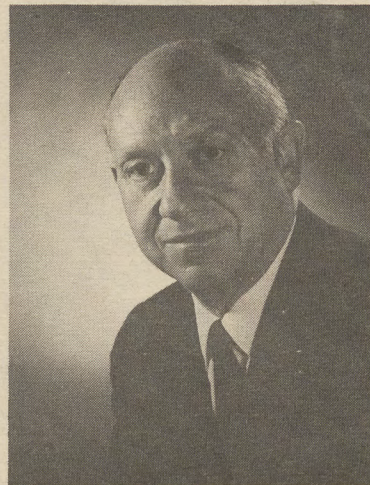
