Veterans Services of JWV Extended to Negro Veterans

In this day of confrontations rather than meeting together to reason out and resolve problems that exist between the black and white communities, it is heartening to report on the spectacular success of The Jewish War Veterans' unique aid to returning Negro veterans.

Just a short time ago when the National Urban Crisis Committee, under Chairman Matthew Feldman, was formed, one of its top priority programs was to involve JWV's Veterans Service Offices in rendering special assistance to the returning Negro veteran.

Because the Negro veteran lacks his own Veterans Service Organization it was felt JWV

could step into this gap and advise these young men of their rights as veterans and also what they are entitled to as veterans under the G.I. Bill.

JWV felt that advising and helping them would go a long way to helping ease the tension while at the same time assisting these veterans to recognize how important their roles can be in their own community.

After all there is little doubt that the future leaders of the Negro community will come from among this group of returning veterans.

Today, National Commander Charles Feuereisen disclosed, "there is greater cooperation (Continued on Page 2)

Rallies and Meetings Result In Merchant's Cooperation

The Jewish War Veterans Boycott of French goods and services is resulting in a boycott of importations from France at a level not dreamed about when the boycott was instituted a few weeks ago.

PNC Morton L. London, Chairman of the JWV National Boycott Committee and his hard-working Committee are busy with coordination of all the activities, plans, and accomplishments in this gigantic boycott campaign.

On a Department-wide, city-wide, country-wide, and community-wide basis, rallies and meetings have been held in many areas of the country (particularly in New York, New Jersey, Baltimore, Washington, Philadelphia, and elsewhere) to implement the JWV policy of the National Boycott against French goods and services.

Boycott Committees on every echelon have been organized, have made plans, and gone into action along the lines that were laid out at the beginning of the Boycott on February 5, 1969.

There are two aspects of this boycott campaign that must be highlighted . . .

(1.) A goal to acquire as many letters as possible going from dealers and merchants to their French sources and to the French government itself (with a copy sent to the JWV), pledging a boycott of French goods and/or services and stating the reason for it.

(2.) Our goal is to activate the personal involvement of every member of The Jewish War Veterans. This entails visits to

stores; seeing that merchants and distributors write letters when they are cooperating with the boycott. In fact the entire strength of the JWV organization is ready and able to give every member the satisfaction of personal support and cooperation.

The national leaders of JWV have been speaking at rallies; had interviews on nationwide radio and TV, all urging full community cooperation with this Boycott instigated by The Jewish War Veterans. And above all explaining fully the basic cause for its instigation.

National Commander Charles Feuereisen personally called upon the French Consul General at his residence in New York, along with New York Department Commander Stanley N. Zwaik, to officially notify the diplomat that JWV was instituting a mammoth boycott against France's goods and services.

Newspapers across the land have taken notice of this effort of JWV and followed through with news items about it. Even the vaunted New York Times had an article in its pages.

In this issue of the Veteran you will read on Page 4 our "White Paper" on the issue which states the "who, what, why" of the situation. This paper in its entirety will be given nationwide distribution within all JWV echelons, accompanied by a memorandum of "how" or suggestions and guidelines for techniques and actions by JWV.
