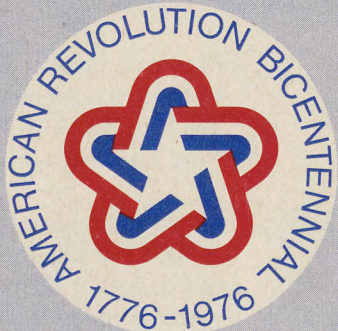

news around the Jewish world

Israel has accused **UNESCO** of premeditated discrimination as a result of its Executive Committee's vote in Paris recently to exclude Israel from a 1976 international educational conference of European and Mediterranean countries to discuss diplomat equivalencies and educational levels among the participants. . . . Congressional investigators probing bribes and other payoffs abroad by companies based in the U.S. expect that the **GULF OIL CORPORATION'S** Chairman Bob R. Dorsey will supply more details on the company's secret contributions to an Arab fund used to propagandize Americans. . . . Twelve to 15 Jewish tombstones were defaced recently in a **BROOKLYN** cemetery. The markers were spray-painted with graffiti.

A joint American-Israeli medical plant has opened its new headquarters as the first enterprise on **HEBREW UNIVERSITY'S** new science-based industry campus in the Sanhedria quarter of Jerusalem The **WEST BERLIN SENATE** has pardoned and released two Nazi criminals serving life sentences on 30 charges of murder. Each had served 21 years. They are Otto Locke, 62, convicted of the murder of seven Jewish inmates of the Birkenau concentration camp, and Gottfried Matthes, a 72-year-old doctor convicted of murdering 23 mentally defective Germans in the Polish town of Grottkau A **U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT** spokesman, Robert Funseth, said he had "no second thoughts" about the U.S. deal to sell Jordan a \$100 million "Hawk" anti-aircraft missile system and other weapons despite reports that Jordan is receiving air defense cover from Syria.

A sculpture symbolizing the Soviet Jewish "Prisoners of Conscience" was dedicated recently in **MINNEAPOLIS**. The six-foot monument contains photographs and personal information on all the prisoners. . . . Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau of **CANADA** has affirmed that his government opposes all discrimination against those Canadian companies which, because they trade with Israel or have Jewish directors, have been placed on the Arab boycott list. . . . Foreign Ministry and Red Cross official in **BRAZIL** have refused to receive Said Absair, a special emissary of PLO chieftain Yasir Arafat. Although Brazil has declared its backing for the "Palestinian cause," it has refused to recognize the PLO as the representative of the Palestinian people After years of steady decline, the state of Jewish education in **ARGENTINA** is beginning to show some slight improvement according to a recent study there. The basic problem there is said to be a shortage of teachers. . . .

Merkos L'inyonei Chinuch, the educational arm of the Lubavitch movement, has announced the opening of its new regional office in **CARACAS**, Venezuela. This is the third Lubavitch office in South America.

Israeli Premier Yitzhak Rabin will pay an official visit to **AUSTRIA** in the second half of August at the invitation of Chancellor Bruno Kreisky. The announcement of the meeting ended rumors that there was friction between the two nations because of Kreisky's alleged pro-Arab stand. . . . Another Jewish cemetery in the **SOVIET UNION** has been destroyed. The cemetery in Sarin in the Ukraine has been turned into a garbage dump with few gravestones still remaining. . . . Israel Aircraft Industries' contribution to the **PARIS** air show, the Stol transport, was co-piloted to Paris by IAI's first woman aviator, Mrs. Yael Nahmias The small **GERMAN** town of Flensburg, near the Danish border, was the scene of a recent neo-Nazi demonstration. The demonstrators shouted slogans against Jews and Jewish organizations. . . . The **WELSH** have successfully adopted the Hebrew ulpan technique in disseminating their language. Business and professional men are said to take time off of work to study Welsh by techniques copied from Israel's system.
